

ORDINANCE NO. 540

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF JEFFERSON, IOWA, 2008, BY AMENDING PROVISIONS PERTAINING TO SPRING AND FALL FREE PICKUP OF BULKY RUBBISH

Be it enacted by the City Council of Jefferson, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Subsection Modified. Subsection 1 of Section 106.05 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Jefferson, Iowa, 2008, is repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof.

106.05 BULKY RUBBISH. . .

1. In the spring and fall of each year the City will provide free pickup of up to 2 garbage truck hoppers (approximately 1½ yards each) of bulky rubbish from all residential premises, except appliances, e-waste (such as computer equipment and photocopiers) and construction debris, with the exact schedule and time of such pickups to be determined and announced by the City Administrator. Amounts picked up in excess of 2 hoppers will be charged at the rate of \$25.00 per hopper or part thereof. Residents having items to be picked up at these times shall place such items on the parking in front of their premises by 6:00 a.m. of the scheduled pickup day. Appliances, e-waste (such as computer equipment and photocopiers) and construction debris may be set out for collection during the free pickup period and will be collected by the City, but such items shall be billed for in accordance with the special items charges under this chapter.

SECTION 2. Severability. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.


SECTION 3. When effective. This ordinance shall be in effect after its final passage, approval and publication as provided by law.


