

Jefferson Park and Recreation Commission Meeting Minutes  
January 24, 2010

Members Present: Rosemary Hoyt, Shannon Black, Doug Meinecke Vicky Lautner, Jeff Lamoureux.

Shannon Black reported the city had okayed the Statue of Doreen Wilbur's statue to be put on the Greene County Community Center site. She mentioned at the swim Team meeting there was a question about not doing private lessons during swim team practice. Jeff explained that the guards were not to give lessons during city lessons. He will go to the next meeting on Sunday Feb 7 to explain the situation to the board.

Jeff reported on the Hess Fund list. The list needs to be prioritized by the board Jeff suggested this order. Gravity System (\$2895), Elliptical (an older style), TV replacements for upstairs and lobby 2-32" and 1-46" (\$3500), Multi media system with DVD/VCR player, projector, and speakers (\$1970), Espresso Exercise Bike (\$6000), Floor mats in the lobby with GCCC logo (\$1200). It was suggested that Jeff get quotes for the TV's from John's and Pamida.

Rosemary suggested putting together a wish list to be printed in the city news for people to purchase in memory of loved ones, or to help out the Community Center.

Jeff said that Norman Lindhart was looking to put a bench at the swimming pool in memory of Jean Lindhardt as she started the first swim team in Jefferson. He said it might go on the east side of the building under the trees in the triangle.

Jeff reported around 50,000 visitors to check in at the front desk in 2009. That does not count the people attending events held at the Greene County Community Center.

No appointments for offices could be discussed or appointed as there were not enough board members in attendance.

Jeff said the Youth Wrestling Tournament after being rescheduled to Sunday, Jan. 17 had 152 wrestlers in attendance with \$1128 gate. He was pleased with the turn out of the rescheduled event. The plan is to keep the meet in January on the same weekend as the JV tournament as Christmas falls on a Saturday in 2010. Having the meet that weekend cuts down on the set up time for the tournament.

With no other business to discuss Rosemary adjourned at 1:00 pm.
