

Pool Rules

1. All patrons must be wearing swim attire, which include a lining and have adequate coverage, if they are in the water swimming or if they are getting clothing wet. No cut-off shorts are to be worn in the pool.
2. The wading pool is limited to children six years old and younger. Please be aware that there are no lifeguards stationed in the baby pool area. Therefore, an adult or care giver must supervise each child at all times.
3. No animals allowed in the pool area.
4. Small inflatable toys are allowed, including water rings. Please be aware of the potential for small children that could get caught underneath. Only soft nerf or beach balls are allowed in the water.
5. Smoking is not allowed on the premises.
6. Running, dunking, spitting, excessive splashing, and horseplay are not allowed. No chicken fighting.
7. No hanging on the ropes or playing on or near the ladders.
8. Jumping into the pool backwards or spinning while jumping is not allowed.
9. No diving in shallow areas, no diving off guard chair, no running, and no unsafe behavior.
10. Only one person on the diving board at a time, must go off the end, and only one bounce. No parent should attempt to catch their child from the board. No swimming under the diving board. No back flips off of the board.
11. Deep water swim testing must be passed before a patron 16 years and under is allowed in the deep water.
12. No parent should attempt to catch a child from the slide. All children must pass the deep water swimming test before going off the diving board or down the slide.
13. No patrons are allowed in the basket room; staff only.
14. The use of abusive or profane language is grounds for ejection from the pool complex.
15. Radios and walkmans are allowed by the patrons, but they must have earphones.
16. All children 9 years and under must be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult. The adult must be within arm's reach of all non-swimmers.
17. All persons must shower before entering the pool. Do not play in the showers.
18. No bikes, rollerblades, scooters, or skateboards are allowed in the pool area.
19. Lifeguards will deny admission to anyone who has a skin abrasion, inflamed eyes, contagious skin rashes, infections, or who is wearing bandages.
20. First aid supplies may be obtained from the lifeguards. All injuries, however slight, must be reported to the lifeguards.

21. A phone is provided for limited use.

Pool Parties

Parties may be booked through the pool manager on a first come basis. The limit is 60 people. The party fee is \$50 for up to 30 people and \$70 for up to 60 people. Inflatable toys are allowed at parties. Please call for more information.

General Pool Information

- Pool hours may vary for swim meets and events.
- Pool opens at 65 degrees and sunny or 68 degrees and cloudy.
- If morning lessons have been canceled due to weather, the pool will not reopen until 1:00 P.M. weather permitting.

- If lightning is seen or thunder heard the pool will close for 20 minutes after each strike or thunder.
- If the pool closes before 5:30 P.M. because of inclement weather, then the weather clears, the pool will reopen at 6.
- If the pool is closed after 5:30 P.M. because of the weather it will remain closed for the day.
- Listen to KGRA or KDLS radio or call our voicemail (386-9838) or the Greene County Community Center (386-3412) to find out if the pool has been closed due to weather.
